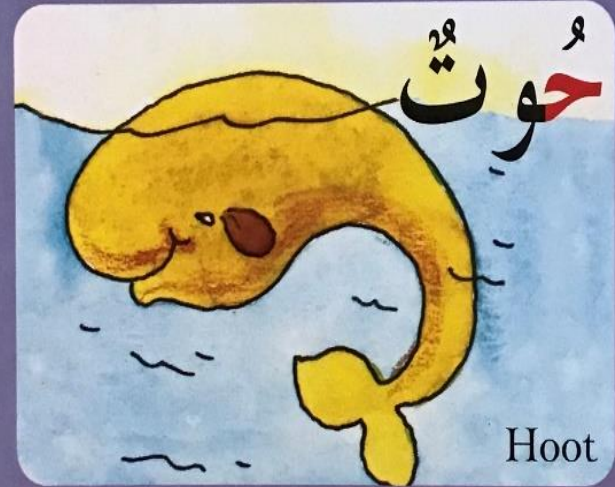
Dear Parents & teachers: Please review with students the names of these alphabets we have learned so far. Point out to the examples. Make students repeat after you.

Let's review the first seven letters we have learned so far: Do you remember?

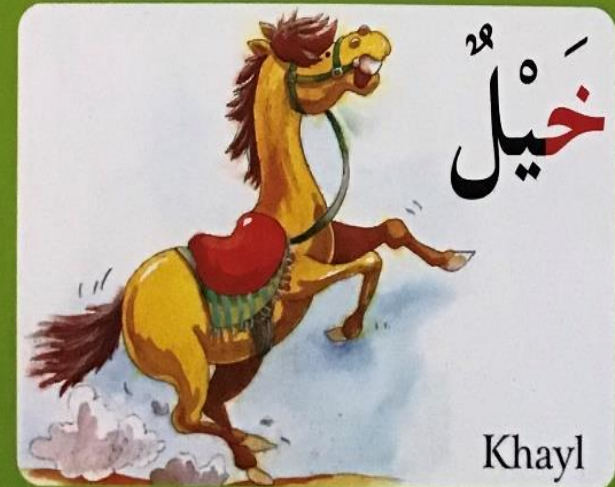
